Dear Danna:

Just a few lines to let you know that last saturday (8/9), the Naturopathic Commission of the Department of State in Puerto Rico unanimously voted for the regulation of Naturopathy. They will make recommendations to the Governor and the Legislature on this subject.

Traditional Naturopathy and the Bastyr style Naturopathic Doctors will be regulated separately. There was no change to the requirements to our Provisional Licence. The requirements of a Bachelor Degree or at least 90 credits including Biology, Chemistry, Anatomy, Physiology, Herbo logy, Physics, Mathematics, Microbiology and Nutrition stands. As far as the Naturopathic requirements, 130 credits (1,950 hours) are mandatory. We are working on the Grandfathers clause.

Most of us already complied with the requirements so we are pleased to see how Naturopathy is being finally "legalized" in Puerto Rico.

I will be mailing to your address my Curriculum Vitae soon along with copies of my Degree, certificates, etc. I am still working on the translation of several documents. My interest is to be certified by you school after paying the dues. I will be using the certification as part of our strategy in the island.
