Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing to you in regards to regulation standards of education in the fields of **healing, esoterics, parapsychology, paramedicine, metaphysics, bioenergetics and energy informational exchange.**

Our company, **Russia Resources L.L.C.**, is working with the **Institute of Eniology and Social Research** of St.Petersburg, Russia.

Presently, the **Institute** is undergoing licensing in higher education in the above mentioned fields. However, there is some difficulty in light of the fact that in Russia to date there has been no precedent of an institution providing **higher education in these fields.**

International standards, namely ISCED 1997 adopted by UNESCO, list subjects that are only remotely pertaining (psychology, philosophy, sociology and business). It is, however, known to us that there do exist higher education institutions in other countries which provide for degrees in **healing, esoterics, parapsychology, metaphysics, bioenergetics and energy informational exchange** and the like.

It is in regards to this problem that we ask for your qualified assistance. To our knowledge, your institution deals with these or related topics. We would appreciate it if you could share with us your knowledge concerning the manner in which your institution obtained the status it presently holds. Any information in regards to national guidelines of your country, domestic and/or international documents or proceedings would be of use.
